Treasures Report – Donnie

Financials: We have 25,764.94. There has not been a lot of activity other than Basketball. They sent fundraising money. \$1855.00 in the Basketball account. Tennis did a fund raider and sent \$\$\$ as well. Swimming also contributed some fundraising funds. \$300 proceeds from Rabbit Ramble went into the general account. Non profit agencies are not supposed to carry more than 10k in money. Checks will be given to scholarship receipt ants at the night of the awards ceremony.

Athletic Director – Steve

Steve will be reordering varsity jackets at the end of May.

We should consider ordering a larger number of jackets since we have more than 10k in our account. No jackets were given away. Steve will be ordering the jackets in two weeks. Steve has requested that the school pay for an additional bookcase, this will not happen. He would like to hang a wall of fame. Steve has a cabinet full of trophies and plaques he would like somewhere to display them. He would like it displayed so everyone that comes to KP can view them. He feels this would be good for KP pride. Boosters could put their name on it. Donnie will get a price for Steve on the cost of providing such a display case. Dick Robbat says we can do it but they don't have the \$\$\$, and it will not appear in any future budgets, board suggested that we get 3 or 4 estimates to build the cases. Steve will get a price. If we can afford to help then we will.

3 on 3 Basketball Tournament – Sean McInnis feels that a Youth 3 on 3 tournaments for both kids and parents would be a great fundraiser. The basketball team would run the tournament. We have a total of 1,000 kids participating in basketball between the three towns. Sean will leave the rules with us. He will also leave instructions on how to break down and set up the tournament. Allowing the teams to be equal. Run free clinics for k-2's, give aways, basketballs. Celtics player will come in during the height of it. Run it throughout the 3 Towns. Basketball program has been well received by Plainville school members. Jeff Plympton and Ann Proto have been great in assisting. Cost would be about \$60.00 per team. \$4.00 per-shirt, 16.00 per player. \$44.00 would go back to the boosters as profit. Concessions would go back to Basketball program. Volunteers would staff the concessions stand so the boys would not be fundraising. Community Service hours would be offered to all KP students. They could follow the rules it would go over 1 and 1 ½ days everyone guaranteed three games. 20 minute time limits. Dads rent the open gym at the middle school, Sean has popped in and they have indicated that they would be interested in helping out. We could have a 30 and over team. Sean was successful at his prior school and raised minimum of \$5,000. Court monitors would be there. Sean has offered to help the Football team with the website. Basketball is running a warrior basketball summer camp. He was able to send 750 emails in 3 minutes. Target specific age groups, this tool is fantastic. Sean assisted in the Weston Boosters web site and now you can sign up on line. Steve could use it for the Hall of Fame dinners. The software package does the bracketing as well. This could be printed up and put on a wall. Patti has touched base on the getting the gyms for the 3 on 3 tournament Paul Schafer said if it rains, we would be bumped out, but if it is a KP athletic event we won't get bumped. 1st weekend in October has already been reserved. Steve will secure the date. Trainer will be needed for injuries. Boosters will cover the cost of the Trainer. The rules were passed out to members.
