Treasurer's Report:

The general account balance is \$10,407.48. Total account balance including all teams is \$15,048.83. Not a lot of activity this month. Basketball coach approached the Boosters Club seeking a Boosters Club advertisement in the upcoming Basketball program. All felt that an ad should be placed especially since the Boosters will benefit from the upcoming 3 vs 3 basketball tournament being held Nov 6 – 8. All of the money from the ad sponsorships will go back to the Basketball team. Full page ad costs \$200. Vote taken and motion was accepted to take a full page ad out for the Basketball program for \$200. Donnie and Todd will put together the ad and send to Patti.

Athletic Director:

Wall of Fame cabinets are in, just waiting on the glass panels and glass shelving. Steve has been in contact with the electrician to get the lights installed. All commented as to how nice the cabinets look. Steve has trophies, plaques, etc dating back to the 1950's which will be cleaned up and displayed once the cabinets are completed. Steve has received 18 new jacket orders (14 Fleece, 4 Varsity). The fleece can be ordered, however, the Varsity jackets have to be ordered in a minimum quantity of 12. Steve will mention the Varsity jackets to Coach Lee for current football players in hopes to receive a few more orders. One more home football game for the concession stand to be open. Since the football team is undefeated thus far, the question came up about playoffs and the potential of home field advantage and the possibility that the concession stand may need to be open for an additional game.

Concession Stand:

Mary and Patti presented a spreadsheet with the Concession Stand financial activity to date. They gave Donnie \$2,500.00 to deposit into the General Account. The concession stand currently has \$1,484.71 cash on hand.

General Discussion:

Patti received a phone call from Rich Pellichero who would like the Booster's Club to consider selling KP Snuggies. The minimum purchase is 48. KP Booster's would need to solicit the KP Snuggies. Donnie mentioned that they could be sold in the DECA store; maybe the kids would buy them. The Board thinks that KP Blankets may be a better sell than the KP Snuggies. Not sure if the DECA Store sells KP Blankets, if so, Booster's Club cannot. Several members are still looking into the cost of the KP Blankets.

Tom Howard brought a sample of the megaphone for popcorn sales. Steve said that megaphones, thunder sticks, horns and any other noise makers are not allowed at the football games per MIAA rules. All great ideas, however MIAA rules are followed.

Sean mentioned, at a previous meeting, that some of his basketball kids will be helping out. Also, any CCD kids that need Community Service would also be a good resource.

Membership checks are coming in slowly. Patti and Tom both gave Donnie their membership dues. Patti also gave Donnie a check for \$30 from the sale of an umbrella.

Dodgeball was brought up and all thought it would still be a Fundraising event in the spring. Rabbit Ramble appears to be a lot of work and very expensive for the little return, will need to discuss this fundraiser at another meeting.

Mary mentioned that Trainer Town Gym in Plainville contacted her regarding new memberships. They couldn't make it to last night's meeting but may be at an upcoming meeting. They would run a weekend special to all Norfolk, Plainville and Wrentham and any new memberships they obtain, the Booster's Club would receive half.

All have seen the new KP signs on the Press Box and think a picture of them should be taken and put on the website. Scott May will take some photos and email them to Dan to post on the Booster's website.

Also noted was that a recognition plaque should be put on the Wall of Fame cabinets stating that the Booster's Club helped sponsor the Wall of Fame.

Steve mentioned that he is trying to comprise a list of name from 1958-2009 who were awarded "Athlete of the Year," however not all of the information is available in the Athletic Office. Suggestion made was to compile the list of names that he currently has and put a note on the Hall of Fame website or/and the Booster's website seeking unknown names.
